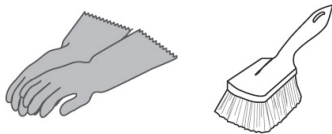

**Tools and supplies**



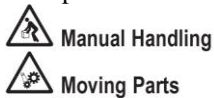
Gloves & Brush, Cloth or Vacuum. A Philips Head Screwdriver is also required to perform task.

**Procedure**

**1 Step**  
Disconnect electrical power supply before cleaning any parts of the unit.



**2 Step**  
Remove the screws from the back panel.



**3 Step**  
Once all the screws are removed, the back panel can be removed.



**4 Step**  
This will allow full access to the back of the system.



**5 Step**  
Brush or wipe any dirt lint or dust from the finned condenser coil, the compressor and other cooling system parts. Care should be taken not to bend any of the condenser fins, as this will reduce performance and compressor life.

**6 Step**  
Replace back panel to original position and replace screws to hold it in place. When cleaning is completed plug cabinet back into proper outlet.
